



DATA PROTECTION WEBINAR

As technology improves, modes of communication increase and as those in the Church become more attuned to the digital age, the risk of breaching the Data Protection Act 1998 (and therefore receiving a hefty fine from the Information Commissioner) is heightened.

With this in mind, the Church of Scotland Law Department, has developed a webinar aimed at office bearers.
