



An experience of a Service of Dedication for a Memorial Bench

On Saturday 21st March 2009 family and members of the community gathered at Carnac Point to dedicate a bench in memory of Joshua Mitchell. The dedication service was led by Rev Alistair Murray of Trinity Church in Inverness. He had been murdered on 22nd March 2008. The cost for the bench was raised by members of the community. Joshua had simply left his family home and about 100 yards from there a boy of around the same age as Joshua, full of drink



and drugs, angry with the world, stabbed Joshua who was in the wrong place at the wrong time. A dedication service was held to offer comfort and support to the family who still are trying to come to terms with their loss. The service was covered in the local newspaper, The Inverness Courier.
