### Andrew McLellan writes about the tour:

Everyone in Israel and Palestine lives behind the wall: hardly anyone understands what it is like on the other side of the wall. We will meet Israelis and Palestinians, Jews, Muslims and Christians, groups and individuals, as we try to go "further in" in our attempt to grasp what day-to-day life is like. We will not be visiting the holy sites. What we will be doing is meeting people, listening and seeking to understand the conflict. We will reflect together on what should be our responses when we return.

Staying five nights each in St Andrew's Guesthouse in Jerusalem and in the Lutheran Guesthouse in Bethlehem, the tour will primarily be of interest to those who have visited before. The cost is £1500 per person in a double room (single supplement £200) and covers flights from Edinburgh, half board accommodation, on ground transportation, gratuities and insurance (for travellers 80 years and under). Places are limited; the closing date for applications is 30 November 2018.
