A search committee, set up by the Kirk Session, is looking for a Christian student worker. Working in partnership with the church elders and as part of a staff team, our student worker will be responsible for leading our existing student ministry (both international and non-international) as well as developing new initiatives. Fluency in mandarin would be essential as the church seeks to reach out to the large community of Chinese students living within 800 yards of the church. Preference may be given to applications from recent graduates. The role will include:

- creating and coordinating effective evangelistic opportunities for student outreach
- welcoming and reaching out in friendship to international students
- developing and delivering a programme of discipleship for Christian students
- caring for and maintaining contact with students and encouraging hospitality within the church family
- leading by example through one to one Bible studies to train students in sharing the message of Jesus
- working with other student groups on behalf of the church to advance the gospel in Glasgow

This is a full-time post, for one year in the first instance, with a salary of £18,000 per annum, beginning September/October 2017.
