- Ensure areas around the entrances and exits are clean and free from debris
- Ensure that any furniture, fixtures or fittings moved by users of the premises are returned to their original place, taking special care to keep routes to the fire exits clear at all times
- Ensure toilets are clean and kept fully supplied with paper goods
- Ensure premises are left clean and tidy and that all dishes and utensils used are washed and put away
- Ensure secure locking-up of the building
- Check the fire exits
